The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press this petition and the petitioner would surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail but the same be directed to be decided expeditiously.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed and it is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week and moves an application for regular bail, the same be decided in accordance with law expeditiously but in any case within a week of its filing.
