This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.281 dated 6.8.2016 registered under Sections 420, 465 IPC, 1860 (Challan presented under Sections 192, 193, 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC) at police station Udhyog Vihar, District Gurugram.

The allegation against the petitioner was that the he conspired in a GST fraud. It is alleged that he sold two C forms of the company in which the main accused was an employee who used those C forms to create a false transaction and to get benefit of tax.

Custody certificate dated 4.3.2019 by way of affidavit of Mohmed Sazeed Khan-Dss, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Gurgaon)-Haryana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel.

As per which the petitioner has been in custody for 1 month and 24 days.

Learned DAG has argued that not only the petitioner sold the forms to the main accused but also got registered a false report about loss of those forms.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner from 11.3.2019. Ordered accordingly, Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
