The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No. 2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Both the petitioners are present in Court and respondent Nos. 4 to 6 have appeared on their own. The parties were referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of some amicable settlement, however, no settlement could be arrived at between the parties.

As per the averments made in the petition, both the petitioners are of marriageable age and have allegedly performed marriage against the wishes of parents and other family members of petitioner No. 1.

In view of the above, without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition

stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to look into the grievance of the petitioners regarding any threat perception to their life and liberty and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances, in accordance with law.

The petitioners are also directed to appear before respondent Nos. 2 and 3 and supply them information about their place of stay along with their mobile numbers.

Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 are further directed to arrange a meeting between the petitioners and respondent Nos. 4 to 6 to further explore the possibility of some settlement.

It is made clear that in case any FIR is registered against petitioner No.2, it will be open for the police authorities to take action, in accordance with law.
