Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondent No.4 not to conduct re-inquiry/multiple inquiries on the complaint filed by respondent No.5 contrary to the standing instructions issued by respondent No.7 i.e. Director General of Police, Punjab as well as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.4—Superintendent of Police City, SAS Nagar, Mohali, is directed to look into the matter, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the

case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4—Superintendent of Police City, SAS Nagar, Mohali to look into matter and do the needful, if required, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
