KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

Even before arguments could commence learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner very fairly stated that since the petitioner has concealed the material facts from this Court in the pleadings which mis-led this Court to pass an interim order dated 13.02.2019, therefore, the petition may be dismissed as not pressed. We do not find any difficulty in accepting the prayer. Albeit we are dismissing the writ petition as not pressed but in our opinion, such litigants who tried to mislead the Court should not let go scot-free and some exemplary costs is required to be imposed to deter such litigants in future. Accordingly, while dismissing the

writ petition as not pressed we imposed a cost of Rs.2,00,000/- to be paid by the petitioner. The cost may be deposited by the petitioner in the “Advocate General Punjab Welfare Fund” to be distributed among the family members of two young members of the Bar, who were working in the Office of Advocate General, and died in an accident. In case the cost is not deposited by the petitioner within two weeks from today the Registrar General shall issue necessary direction to the concerned Collector of the district to recover the same as arrears of land revenue and to remit the same to the above noted fund.
