This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to take action against respondents No.5 & 6 in case FIR No.03 dated 15.06.2017 offence under Section 7/13 (2) Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Ludhiana and further to properly investigate the above said FIR.

The allegation is that the petitioner had lodged an FIR against private respondents No.5 & 6 who are working in the PSPCL for demanding bribe from him. Thereafter they have cut his electricity and are repeatedly threatening him that they will not let his electricity be restored.

In my opinion, there is no question of life and liberty.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed with costs of Rs.5,000/-.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
