The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to the respondents to extend the period of parole of the petitioner for three weeks under Section 3(1)(a) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 to attend ill mother of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Neeraj Poswal, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. In view of the urgency of the case, no formal reply is being called for.

The petitioner had been convicted for offence under Section 302 IPC and sentenced to undergo life imprisonment. He was directed to be released on parole vide order dated 21.01.2019 by this Court passed in CWP-1680-2019 for a period of 14 days in order to attend his mother who was critically ill. This period will expire on 14.02.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that his mother has suffered heart attack and he has placed on record medical report as Annexure P-2.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the parole period of the petitioner is extended by one week i.e from 14.02.2019 to 21.02.2019. The petitioner will be required to surrender before the Superintendent, Central Jail-I, Hisar on or before 5.00 P.M. on 21.02.2019.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
