By way of present petition, petitioner has sought quashing of order dated 23.10.1990 (Annexure P-8), whereby benefits of military service have been negated to him. Further prayer has been sought for granting him benefits in accordance with Rule 4 of the Punjab Government National Emergency Concession Rules, 1965 towards increments and seniority with consequential relief.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 16.10.2019 passed by this Court, his multiple attempts to establish contact with the petitioner have been futile.

3. It seems that due to sheer pendency of the writ petition for the past 23 years has either rendered the relief sought herein infructuous or the petitioner has otherwise lost interest in pursuing the same.

4. Accordingly, writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move appropriate application, in case, any cause of action still survives.
