HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 9.

It has been averred that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 20.03.1999 and date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 10.05.1999 and copy of Pan Card of petitioner No.1 and Aadhar Card of petitioner No.2 to this effect are attached as Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively.

It has been submitted that marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 10.02.2019 as per Hindu rites at Tridev Sanatan Dharam Prachar Samiti, Mata Mansa Devi Market, Sector-4, Panchkula. The marriage certificate and photographs of marriage are attached as Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively. Private respondents No.4 to 9 are opposed to the

marriage, as the petitioners had performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 11.02.2019 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the validity of the marriage and the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Lata Singh vs. State of U.P. And another, 2006 (2) SCC (Criminal) 478*, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law.
