RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Criminal Procedure Code for grant of regular bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No.226 dated 01.10.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 370, 376DA/506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'); Section 6/17 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Sections 3(2)(v) of the Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes Act, at Women Police Station Jind, District Jind.

This court would like to reproduce the relevant part of the FIR as under:-

“They used to ill treat us. They have been running the business of prostitution in this house for the last many years. A number of people, including some police personnel, keep visiting here for the purpose of committing wrong acts. They want to forcibly include me also in this business of prostitution. Wrong act was done against me by Arun, Pintu and many other unknown persons for the last 6-7 months. When wrong act was committed against me by Arun then I informed my mother Mithlesh and my mother Mithlesh threatened me, scared me and told me to stay quiet.

They indulge in the business of prostitution and blackmailing people after implicating them in false cases and with this motive my mother has levelled false allegations against Roshan Lal also. I was very disturbed by the wrong acts committed by them. My mother and Arun conspired together to involve me in their business and to sell me. I was very scared and on dated 19.08.2018 I ran away from home. On dated 20.09.2018 the police caught me and took me to the police station.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the story putforth by the prosecution is not reliable.

At this stage, this court is not to meticulously examine the evidence. However the allegations levelled against the petitioners are serious in nature. The trial is in progress.

No ground is made out to grant bail to the petitioners.

Petition is dismissed accordingly.
