GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although FIR No.99 dated 1.8.2014 under Section 365 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Sadar Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar was lodged way back in the year 2014 pertaining to disappearance of petitioner's husband, but no headway has been made in the investigation so far.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary

steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest and also to ensure that the matter pertaining to the aforesaid FIR is investigated fairly and expeditiously and final report is filed at the earliest preferably within a period of 4 months from today.

3. A copy of this order along with copy of the representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
