2. The present Revision Petition purports to have been preferred against the order passed by the Ld. Additional District and Sessions Judge-VI, Jalandhar on 18th January, 2019 (Annexure P-1), in relation to the objections filed against the pending Execution by the Petitioners.

3. It transpires that actually no categorical order allowing or rejecting those objections, was passed by the Ld. Court below.

4. However, perusal of the Execution Application filed by the Respondents itself discloses an ambiguity about exactly which Award is sought to be executed.

5. Faced with this, Ld. Counsel for the Respondents seeks liberty to withdraw the Execution pending before the Ld. Court below, in order to avail of appropriate remedies available to him in accordance with law.

6. After hearing both sides and in the interest of justice, the present Revision Petition is ordered to be dismissed as not pressed in view of the prayer of the Respondents' side to withdraw their own Execution Application for which liberty is granted. They may approach the concerned Forum to seek the appropriate relief admissible to them in the circumstances, and in entertaining such application to be filed, the concerned Forum is expected to be mindful of the time taken by the Respondents in pursuing the Execution Application.
