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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition for regular bail in case FIR No. 50 dated 09.06.2018 registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka, for the offence under Section 306, 34 IPC.

The allegations against the petitioner in the FIR registered on the statement of one Kuldeep Singh are that his uncle's son Toni aged about 25 years was married with Sukhpreet Kaur three years before at village Mugni Kalan District Bathinda. The petitioner was mediator in the said marriage. Tony and his wife Sukhpreet Kaur used to quarrel. They used to visit the house of the petitioner. About 2-3 days prior to the present incident, Sukhpreet Kaur had gone to her parental home after the quarrel. Tony reach the house of the petitioner after consuming liquor to know about the whereabouts of his wife. At around 5 PM Tony was found lying in the street near the house of the petitioner. He was taken to hospital where he died. It was alleged that the petitioner and his family members had either given some poison to Tony or beaten him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 21.08.2018. The investigation in this case is complete. Challan has been presented in the Court.

Considering that the trial may take long time and in view of the fact that the petitioner has been in custody since 21.08.2018, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars. Accordingly, the petition is allowed.

The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
