By way of this writ petition, the petitioner assailed the order dated 4.10.1996 (Annexure P-1) and the order dated 5.11.1996 (Annexure P-2). He sought a further direction to the Food Corporation of India, the respondent herein, to promote him on par with others similarly situated.

No interim orders were granted in this writ petition.

There is no representation for the petitioner or his learned counsel when the matter is taken up for hearing. Perusal of the record reflects that the date of birth of the petitioner is 10.10.1951. He would therefore have retired from service, upon attaining the age of superannuation, long ago. The question of granting him service benefits at this late stage with retrospective effect would not arise. Further, the petitioner seems to have no interest in pursuing this case.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
