The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.197 dated 4.9.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 376/511 of Indian Penal Code and 7 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012 at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that this is a case where allegations have been levelled against the petitioner that he made an attempt to commit rape on a deaf and dumb. He further states that petitioner is in custody since 5.9.2018. Learned State counsel submits that prosecution witnesses have been examined and the trial is at the fag end.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Sony @ Sony Singh @ Sonu Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate Moga, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437 (3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality, the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
