ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 558, dated 31.08.2017, under Sections 353, 186, 307, 115, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat in which Sections 148, 149 and 120-B IPC and Section 27/54/59 of the Arms Act added later on.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are primarily against co-accused Deepak, who is alleged to have fired in the air but no one was injured in the incident. The petitioner was not named in the FIR. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody since 06.01.2018. He also contends that co-accused Deepak has already been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-39585-2018 on 03.04.2019. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Balwan Singh states that 06 out of 34 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when no injury was caused in the incident, the petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 04 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
