The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.260 dated 29.12.2018, registered under Sections 323, 354, 354-A IPC, at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 14.02.2019 is made

absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

and further subject to payment of Rs.45,000/- to one sister, Jasvir Kaur and Rs.15,000/- to the second sister Amarjeet Kaur.

Petition stands allowed.
