The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0202, dated 8.12.2017, registered under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Recovery in this case is 16 injections of Buprenorphine of 2 ml each and 16 vials of Avil of 10 ml each.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has now been in custody for 1 year and about 3 months and no other case is pending against him and till now only one witness has been examined.

Custody certificate has been filed, as per which the petitioner has undergone custody of 1 year 2 months and 22 days.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from HC Baljinder

Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to conclude in the near future, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
