Prayer in the 2nd petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.220 dated 05.09.2018 under Section 376 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

The earlier petition filed by the petitioner i.e. CRM-M-1479-2019 was dismissed as withdrawn, enabling the petitioner firstly to approach the Court of Session for the relief claimed in the present petition. It is thereafter when learned Sessions Judge had declined anticipatory bail to the petitioner vide order dated 02.02.2019, he has filed the second petition.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Satpal submits that in the aforesaid FIR, police has already prepared the cancellation report which has been approved by the SP(D) and is likely to be presented in the

court in due course of time.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid development, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.

It is made clear that in case the police requires the petitioner in the present case, 07 days' prior notice would be given to him.
