Aggrieved against the order dated 05.01.2019, passed by the learned Addl. Principal Judge, Family Court, Ambala, vide which the respondent-wife has been awarded Rs.3,000/- per month as maintenance, the petitioner has preferred the instant petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a tailor and is earning Rs.10,000/- per month. However, it is also claimed that infact two children are residing with him.

Heard. This Court is of the view that the maintenance granted to the respondent-wife is highly on the meagre side. There is no scope of reduction therein. Apart from it, the case is at a preliminary stage and the maintenance can be altered as per circumstances of the case.

In view of aforesaid discussion, finding no merit in the instant petition, the same is hereby dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted

that the petitioner is interested in mediation.

Heard. The petitioner is directed to submit an application for mediation before the court below.
