The petitioner states that e-auction notice dated 01.02.2019 be quashed on the ground that few of the plots including plot No.B-63(P), B-63A, B-63B, B-63C(P), Phase 8, Focal Point, Ludhiana are under litigation.

To a pointed question as to what is the interest of the petitioner, it is stated that he is the person who is interested in e-auction of one of the plots and a serious dispute is pending regarding the ownership even though he has faced proceedings under the Public Premises Act.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, we are of the opinion that e-auction notice cannot be quashed particularly when the petitioner would be having remedies before the appropriate fora where the litigation is pending.
