ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.888, dated 21.10.2017, under Sections 186, 332, 353, 307, 379-B, 395 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Karnal, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with others had snatched purse and mobile phone of a truck driver after he was beaten up. The injury for which Section 307 IPC has been invoked was attributed to co-accused Sher Singh alias Sheru. The petitioner is about 22 years of age and is in custody for over 1 year and 10 months. He is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Rishi Parkash states that 07 out of 16 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 10 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
