In the present writ petition, the grievance which has been raised by the petitioner is that he is entitled for counting military service rendered during the emergency for the grant of pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel further states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has made representation dated 15.11.2018 (Annexure P-5) to the respondents, which is still pending and has not been decided so far and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the representation by passing a speaking order.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation

dated 15.11.2018 (Annexure P-5) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
