Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a criminal complaint case No. 86 dated 13.09.2017, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bilaspur.

On 14.02.2019, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Contends that suspension of the petitioner has already been set aside by the Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Development and Panchayats Department, vide order dated 23.07.2018 (P-2). Further contends that petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 14.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the proceedings before learned trial Court and in case of doing so, she be released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing subject to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of the order dated 14.02.2019, the petitioner has joined the proceedings before learned trial Court and was released on interim bail by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Pataudi vide order dated 20.02.2019.

On instructions from the police official present in the Court, the above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2.

In view of the above, the order dated 14.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off.
