The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.112 dated 6.8.2014 at Police Station City Nawanshahar, District Nawanshahar (SBS Nagar) under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The allegations are to the effect that the petitioner had duped the complainant of an amount of ₹3.50 lacs on the pretext of sending the complainant to 'Kuwait'.

Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the parties have infact compromised the matter and has referred to the compromise deed (Annexure P-3).

The learned State counsel has feigned ignorance about the compromise. The learned State counsel has, however, informed that the

petitioner has been in custody since the last 2½ months and that the challan has already been presented.

Bearing the aforesaid facts in mind, especially the custody period of the petitioner and while also noticing the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the parties have compromised the matter, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner Manga is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
