MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (Oral)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.64 dated 23.03.2016, under Section 379-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Baroda, District Sonapat.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 20.02.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that co-accused of the petitioner namely Sher Singh and Satpal have already been acquitted by the learned trial Court vide judgment dated 30.07.2018 and petitioner is ready to join the proceedings.

Notice of motion for 18.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court and in case he moves an application for bail, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety

bonds to its satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

It has been pointed out by learned Counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 20.02.2019, petitioner has joined the proceedings before learned trial Court on 28.02.2019 and he has produced copy of the said order. The same is retained on file and marked as 'X'.

In view of above, interim order dated 20.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and would not repeat such lapse(s) in future.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
