HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had retired from service on 30.09.2014 and despite expiry of more than four years, the benefits, for which the petitioner is entitled for on retirement, have not been released.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with various representations starting from Annexures P-3 to P-5, which have not been replied by the respondents so far. Counsel further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case the respondents are directed to decide the representations Annexures P-3 to P-5 which are pending consideration with the respondents in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representations Annexures P-3 to P-5, the present writ petition is

disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representations Annexures P-3 to P-5 within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the representations, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
