Petitioners Sanjeev and Monica have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 to 10, who are parents, brother and other relatives of petitioner No.2. The petitioners have annexed copies of their Aadhar Cards indicating that petitioners are aged 21 years and 26 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

At this stage, Mr. Pawan Atttri, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.5, 6 and 7 and has filed Vakalatnama, which is taken on record. Respondents No.5, 6 and 7 are also present in person.

The learned counsel for respondents No.5, 6 and 7 has requested that respondents No.5, 6 and 7 may be permitted to meet petitioner No.2-Monica for a short while.

Acceding to the aforesaid request, the aforesaid respondents were permitted to have a word with petitioner No.2-Monica for a short while, outside the Court room. After they came back, respondents No.5, 6 and 7 were advised not to cause any harm to the petitioners and not to take law in their hands.

The learned counsel for respondents No.5, 6 and 7 has assured that respondents No.5, 6 and 7 or any of their relatives will not harm the petitioners in any manner.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kurukshetra (Haryana) to look into the representation dated 11.2.2019 (Annexure P-4) made by petitioner No.2-Monica, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not be taken to be an expression as regards validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
