Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Devinder Singh, DSP, Kapurthala, states that the retiral benefits have been calculated but could not be released because of some technical objection by the Treasury. He states that needful will be done within six weeks from today.

In view of the statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of. However, it is made clear that if the statement made today is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and in case the petitioner is forced to revive the petition, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting officer/official.
