The petitioner seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.82, dated 25.4.2017, registered under Section 21, 22 & 25 of NDPS Act 1985 registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner has stated that this is a completely false case and the petitioner has been in custody for five months.

Custody certificate dated 25.2.2019 by way of affidavit of Iqbal Singh Dhaliwal, Dy. Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. The custody certificate corroborates the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for 4 months and 11 days.

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Learned DAG has stated that in this case there is only 9 official witnesses and the case is now fixed for 15.3.2019 and the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 15.5.2019 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

I find this to be a fair submission. Consequently, even while dismissing this petition, the Trial Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail in case the prosecution fails to conclude its entire evidence on or before 15.5.2019 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands dismissed.
