The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 5 to conduct medico-legal examination of the prosecutrix on the basis of representations dated 30.11.2018 (Annexures P2 and P3) and subsequently further sections may kindly be added in FIR No.0250 dated 26.11.2018, registered under Section 346 IPC at Police Station Pinagwan, District Nuh.

The prosecutrix in her statement has submitted that she was forcibly raped by private respondents and she has not been medico legally examined inspite of her request to this effect.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 4-State.

Mr. Vikas Chopra, DAG, Haryana, who is present in court has accepted notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4-State. Complete copy

of the paper book has been supplied to him.

Government of U.P. And others; 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979*.
