This order will dispose of two contempt petitions bearing COCN Nos.617 and 618 of 2019, as common questions of law and facts are involved therein.

Short replies by way of affidavits of Gurlovleen Singh Sidhu, Managing Director, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala dated 29.4.2019 have been filed stating therein that the amount towards interest on the delayed amount of gratuity, leave encashment and GPF has been transferred to the concerned depots for depositing the same in the respective saving accounts of the petitioners and for the amount of interest on GPF, the Corporation has issued cheques to the petitioners.

In view of the above, the contempt petitions are dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the amount already stands deposited in the account of the petitioners except for which the cheques have been issued.

The petitioners are at liberty to collect the said cheques from the office of the respondent.
