By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner as enumerated in his complaint Annexure P-1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the sister and brother-in-law of the petitioner had expired leaving behind a minor son. Learned counsel has submitted that property of the minor is being misappropriated by respondents No.4 to 6.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of the complaint dated 18.1.2019 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously. In case the allegations

leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of complaint Annexure P-1 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
