This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.230 dated 26.10.2012 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC, 1860 at Police station Chhapar, District Yamunanagar.

Custody certificate dated 18.2.2019 by way of affidavit of Dr. Rajeev-Dsp, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Yamuna Nagar)-Haryana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for almost 1 year.

Learned DAG has pointed out that in this very case the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender on two occasions and only two witnesses are remain to be examined

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of the facts, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate. Trial Court is directed to justify in demanding heavy security in view of proclamation of the petitioner.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
