Through this petition, the petitioner has sought for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.176 dated 17.04.2015 registered under Sections 279, 337, 338, 304-A IPC at Police Station Sector-58, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in this very case initially the petitioner was granted the concession of bail pending trial. However, due to unavoidable circumstances, he could not appear on some dates, as a result of which, bail of the petitioner was cancelled. Thereafter, the petitioner surrendered before the trial Court on 28.1.2019. Since then he is in custody. He further submitted that the petitioner undertakes to attend the proceedings before the trial Court regularly.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, being instructed by SI Jagbir Singh submits that since the petitioner has already jumped the bail, therefore, he does not deserve any concession of bail. However, it is not disputed that earlier the petitioner was granted the concession of bail pending trial.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, but without

expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
