Special leave to appeal has been sought against the judgment of acquittal passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class while dismissing the complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents has pointed out that respondent no.1, who was the sole proprietor of the respondent-firm, has died on 21.08.2019. Death Certificate of respondent no.1 issued by the Registrar (Birth and Death), Municipal Corporation Yamunanagar, has been produced, which is taken on record.
