This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest or appearance before the trial Court, Mukerian District, Hoshiarpur in FIR No.162 dated 24.12.2012 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC at P.S. Mukerian District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to now deposit the penalty. He further states that prior to this date the petitioner had never misused the concession of bail and had never remained absent.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pawan Sharda, Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Copy of the paper book has been supplied.

In my considered opinion, in case the aforesaid assertion is correct, then the petitioner is entitled to concession of anticipatory bail.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court who shall grant him the concession of anticipatory bail to its satisfaction and subject to the condition that he also deposit the penalty.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
