Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.199 dated 27.08.2017 under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that in terms of order dated 26.10.2018, balance payment has already been made and that fact has been affirmed by learned counsel representing the complainant.

The parties have taken a stand that the matter has been settled by way of compromise and the offence involved in the case is primarily of civil nature. The petitioner has already joined the investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.03.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
