This revision petition is directed against order dated 25.09.2018, passed by Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Mukerian, vide which, he had accepted an application under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC for amendment of plaint filed by the plaintiff, so as to plead in a suit for specific performance that he was and is ready and willing to execute and get registered the sale deed. The defendant/revisionist is aggrieved by that order.

I have gone through the impugned order, which, I find to be well reasoned, not suffering from any illegality or infirmity, much less apparent on the face of it. The order is certainly not perverse or in violation of settled legal position. There is no reason to upset the order by exercising revisional jurisdiction.
