AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The writ petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of with the direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner as per policy dated 01.10.2003 and in view of judgment passed in CWP No.2009 of 2016 titled as ***Balwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others***. The contempt petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience.

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply of Dr. Hardeep Singh, Director General, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Haryana was filed pleading that Letters Patent Appeal (LPA) was preferred against the judgment dated 30.10.2018 of learned Single Judge. LPA was

allowed and matter was remanded back to learned Single Judge to decide afresh.

In view of said fact, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

The contempt petition is dismissed.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to file fresh contempt petition in case cause of action survives after decision of the remand matter.

The rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
