Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure Code for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect petitioner's life and liberty along with its employees/workers who have been appointed as Labour/Cartage contractor for handling the transportation foodgrains at Ram Pura Phul Centre, District Bathinda by the Food Corporation of India.

It is not in dispute that the representation given by the petitioner(s) stands considered by the authority and the necessary steps have been taken to redress grievance.
