This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.10 dated 18.01.2019 registered under Sections 458/323/380/148/149 IPC at Police Station City Sangrur.

On 15.02.2019 the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion for 14.03.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Counsel for the petitioners states that the matter has been compromised and the petition for quashing on the basis of compromise has already been filed. He further states that the statements have been recorded and the matter has been fixed for 20.03.2019.

Counsel for the complainant and learned Senior Deputy Advocate General on instructions from SI Gurtej Singh have accepted this fact.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 15.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
