By invoking Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have prayed for quashing of FIR No.27 dated 02.03.2018, under Section 366 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Reply by way of affidavit of Amarjeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Jalalabad, District Fazilka, on behalf of respondent No.2 already filed by learned State counsel is taken on record. As per the same, petitioner and prosecutrix have married and started living as husband and wife and now the State has recommended for cancellation.

Affidavit of prosecutrix is available on record. Apart from it, there is a certificate of marriage issued by the Marriage Registration Officer-V, Ghaziabad.

For the foregoing reasons, the petition is allowed. Consequently, FIR No.27 dated 02.03.2018, under Section 366 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka stands quashed qua petitioners.
