Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the notices dated 09.08.2018 (Annexure P-1) and 05.01.2019 (Annexure P-2) issued under Section 13(2) and 13(4) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to either approach the bank or to avail the alternative remedies as are available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to him, in accordance with law.
