This order is in continuation of the earlier order passed by this Court in CWP No. 21333 of 2018 on 27.08.2018 by giving directions to the respondents to decide the representation filed by the petitioners dated 12.02.2018 within a period of two months from the receipt of the certified copy.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that inadvertently in the said writ petition i.e. CWP No. 21333 of 2018, the impleaded respondents were not the competent authority, who were to decide the claim of the petitioners and due to the said mistake, the order for deciding the representation dated 12.02.2018 passed by this Court on 27.08.2018 in CWP No. 21333 of 2018 is not being complied with. Hence, the petitioners had no option but to file the present writ petition by impleading the respondents, who are competent to decide the claim being raised by them in

the present writ petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will be satisfied in case a direction is given to respondent No. 2 to pass the appropriate orders on the representation dated 12.02.2018 (Annexure P-6) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that this Court expresses no opinion at this stage in respect of the merits of the case or the admissibility of the plea as being raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition or in the representation.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
