This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.272 dated 22.11.2018 registered under Sections 326/323/34 IPC at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the FIR was lodged after six days.

As per allegations *datar* blow was on the head but what has been shown in the MLR there is a depressed fracture but that could not have been possible unless there was a cut.

Learned Sr. DAG has tried to defend the order declining bail.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is

allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 05.04.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
