The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.124, dated 13.11.2018, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 307, 148, 149 of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that this is a version and cross version case. Petitioner No.2 received injuries which answer the description of an offence under Section 326 of the IPC, while only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioners.

These factual assertions have not been disputed by counsel for the complainant as well as by learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from

ASI Narinder Singh.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
