By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.136 dated 22.09.2014, registered under Sections 21/22/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Valtaha, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on one date, i.e. 25.10.2017, the petitioner could not appear before the learned trial Court due to noting of wrong date and his bail bonds and surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to the State and warrants of arrest were issued against him. Then the petitioner approached this Court by filing the present petition.

Vide order dated 16.10.2018, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within seven days and it was further directed that on his doing so, he be released on interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bikram Singh, states that the petitioner has since appeared before the learned trial Court and has been granted interim bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 16.10.2018 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
