Prayer in the application is to grant leave to appeal against the judgment acquitting the alleged accused. Learned trial Court while passing the order has noticed that the civil litigation is pending between the parties and the parties are neighbours. Accused No.4 is serving in Indian Army and was not resident of the village where the accident took place. It has been alleged that in absence of husband of the complainant, she was given merciless beating. However, only independent witness who was named, was given up. The Court has recorded cogent reasons while passing the judgment.

Learned counsel appearing for the appellant, although, made sincere effort but could not convince the Court to interfere in the judgment passed. Hence, the prayer for grant of leave is rejected.

Consequently, the appeal is dismissed.
