Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 & 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 08.10.1994 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-4) depicting his year of birth as 1997. They have also moved a representation before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (Annexure P-7) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and

certifying the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-7).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
